Attention Bum's

As many of you already know, we will now be posting ALL of our scores individually. The computer is located in the Pro Shop @ the right side of the counter.

It is the responsibility of every golfer in the Men's club to post every score immediately after completing a round of golf. Be sure you know and use the EQUATIBLE STROKE CONTROL SYSTEM FOR ALL POSTING. If you play at an away course it is recommended that you post at whatever course you play if they have a computer, If not, you will have to post @ The Moor ASAP.

This system has been working fairly well, with few exceptions in the short time we have had the new computer in place, please treat this as a reminder.

I hope the transition will continue to go smoothly but please be aware that PENALTIES can be assessed if posting of all scores is not being done and Equitable stroke control is not being used.

If you have any concerns or questions or concerns please feel free to ask. There is also a lot of valuable information on the OGA website under the Handicapping heading. Thank you,
